Abstract. All remaining fonts should be Times New Roman, size 11. Abstract should be three lines under the author information, left and right justified, displaced 12 mm (1/2 inch) from left and right margins.

1. Introduction

Section headings should be center and bold face. Fonts should be Times New Roman 11. The page margins should be set to 25 mm (1 inch) on top, bottom and sides of pages. (If you are using A4 paper, set bottom margin to 42 mm..)

References should be included [*Winglee et al.*, 2002] in square brackets, italics for the authors, followed by year in regular text.

Paragraphs should have no indent. Skip one line between header and text.

1.1. A Subsection

Subsections should have a title left justified in italics You can use your imagination if you have a sub-subsection etc.

2. Figures

All figures should be embedded in text (required). Single or double column figures can used. An example of a single column figure with caption is included on the next page.

The hard copy version of the proceedings will be in black and white, except when color figures are

absolutely necessary. In the latter case a written requests should accompany your manuscript submission. There will be a \$200 charge per page for color. If we do not receive any such request and if you do not receive any confirmation that we have received such a request from you, then all color figures will be published as black and white, but a full color version in PDF will be posted on the web.

3. Page Limits

Invited papers should be limited to 8 pages. Contributed papers should be limited to 6 pages.

4. Submission Details

Submissions to the proceedings will be done electronically. PDF files of your manuscript should be e-mail to winglee@ess.washington.edu. Please use the last name of the corresponding author in the filename. These submissions will be processed manually. If you do not receive an acknowledgement of receipt of the manuscript within a few days of submission, please contact. You will be contacted if there are any problems in opening the PDF files.

Submission deadline June 17, 2002.

5. An Example Figure

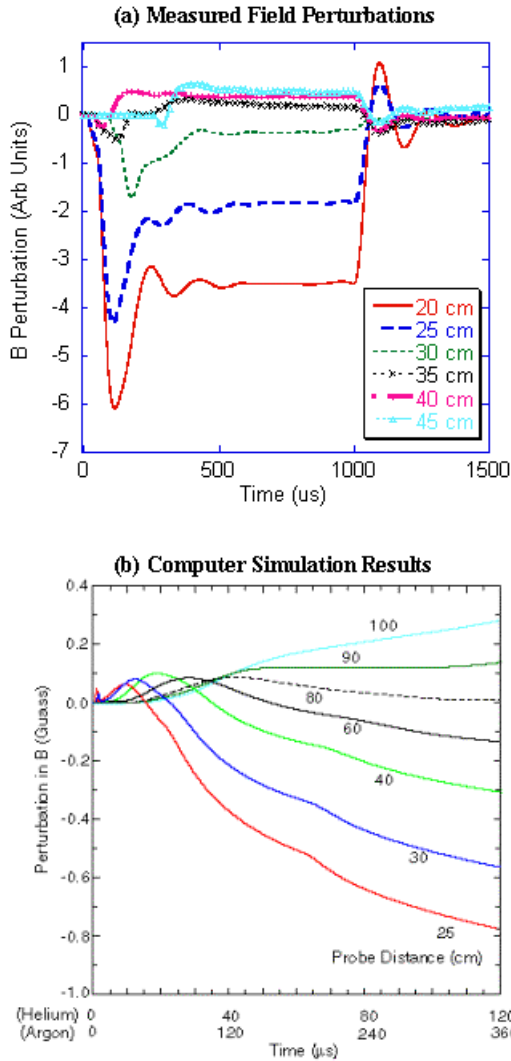


Figure 1. An example a single column figure showing a comparison of (a) the observed magnetic field perturbations and (b) computer simulations. Caption should be Font Size 11, left/right justified, and aligned with the column.

6. Double Column Figures

For a double column, the margin settings should be no larger than that of the abstract (i.e. the figure should approach no closer than 1/2 (13mm) inch from either side of the full width of the double column text.

7. Summary and Conclusion

A hard copy of the proceedings will be printed and sent out to participants.
