2. **Donor's preference is that recipient have a permanent right to work in the United States.**
3. **May not have a RA/TA appointment at the same time as this fellowship. However, the Department may supplement this award up to the Dept's GSA rate for a student of similar level.**

**Osberg Endowed Presidential Fellowship:**

1. High academic merit.
2. Nominee must be a graduate of a U.S. high school.
3. **Donor's preference is that recipient be on Ph.D. track with long range goal of career in academia.**
4. **May not have a RA/TA appointment at the same time as this fellowship. However, the Department may supplement this award up to the Dept's GSA rate for a student of similar level.**
