Introduction

- Objective is to make more minority students interested in engineering, and increase the number of minority students in engineering departments.



Interest

- We want to help engineering students who may not have been able to experience the subject in their high schools
- There is a missed pool of talent with the new system



Problem Statement

- People should be given a chance to learn about engineering
- Its importance is to increase the number of underrepresented minorities interested in the program



Intervention

- Engineering Major & Diversity Seminar
 - Time - once every week during lunch time
 - Management - Dean's Office
 - Location - central campus or near dorms
 - Ex. ECC, IC, Disabilities Resource Center, etc.
 - Incentives
 - Free food, prizes, faculties/students of color or varying abilities



Expected Results

- Increase in engineering interest from underrepresented minorities
- Increase in minority students in engineering
- Future retention of underrepresented minorities in engineering majors
